We called 8th and 9th class students of Deogiri Global Academy, Parbhani. **62** students were visited in the Science Exhibition along with their teachers.. The exhibition was thoughtfully designed to showcase a wide range of biological specimens, laboratory instruments, charts, and working models, providing an integrated learning experience.

A main attraction of the exhibition was the display of museum specimens representing different animal phyla. These specimens helped students understand the diversity of life forms, their structural organization, and evolutionary relationships. In addition to preserved specimens, we also exhibited preserved endangered mammals, which created awareness about biodiversity conservation and the importance of protecting threatened species.

Various informative charts and models were prepared by students, illustrating important biological concepts in a simple and visually appealing manner. which made complex ideas easier to understand.

The exhibition also featured a comprehensive display of laboratory instruments used in biological research and analysis.
