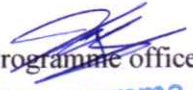
Celebration of International Women's Day

During this session, the female students underwent a health check-up and received appropriate guidance regarding diet and lifestyle habits. On this occasion, he also advised incorporating foods such as flaxseeds, safflower seeds, and sesame seeds into one's diet. Dr. Shivani Chaudhary also offered her guidance during the event.

Mahatma Phule Birth Anniversary Celebration

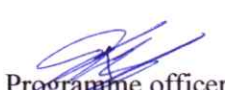

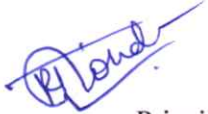
Red Ribbon Marathon Organized

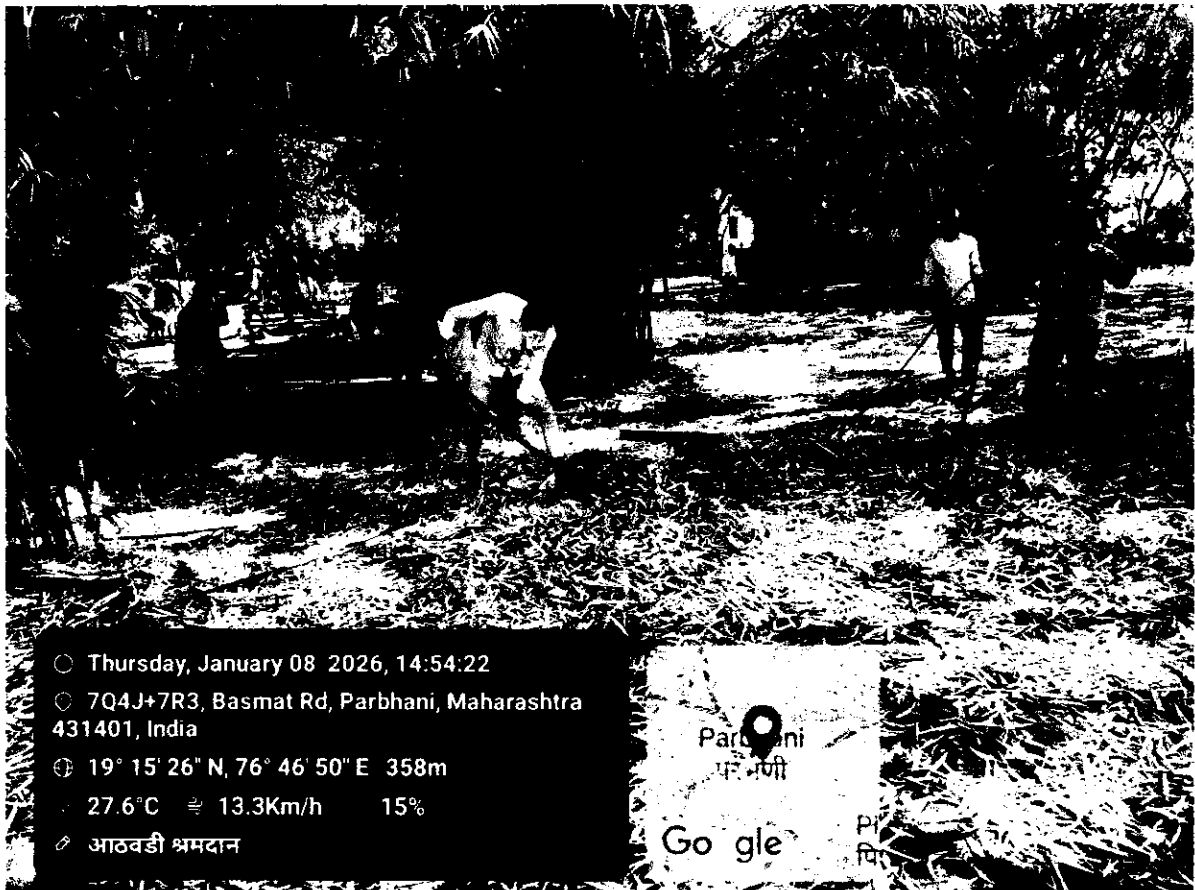

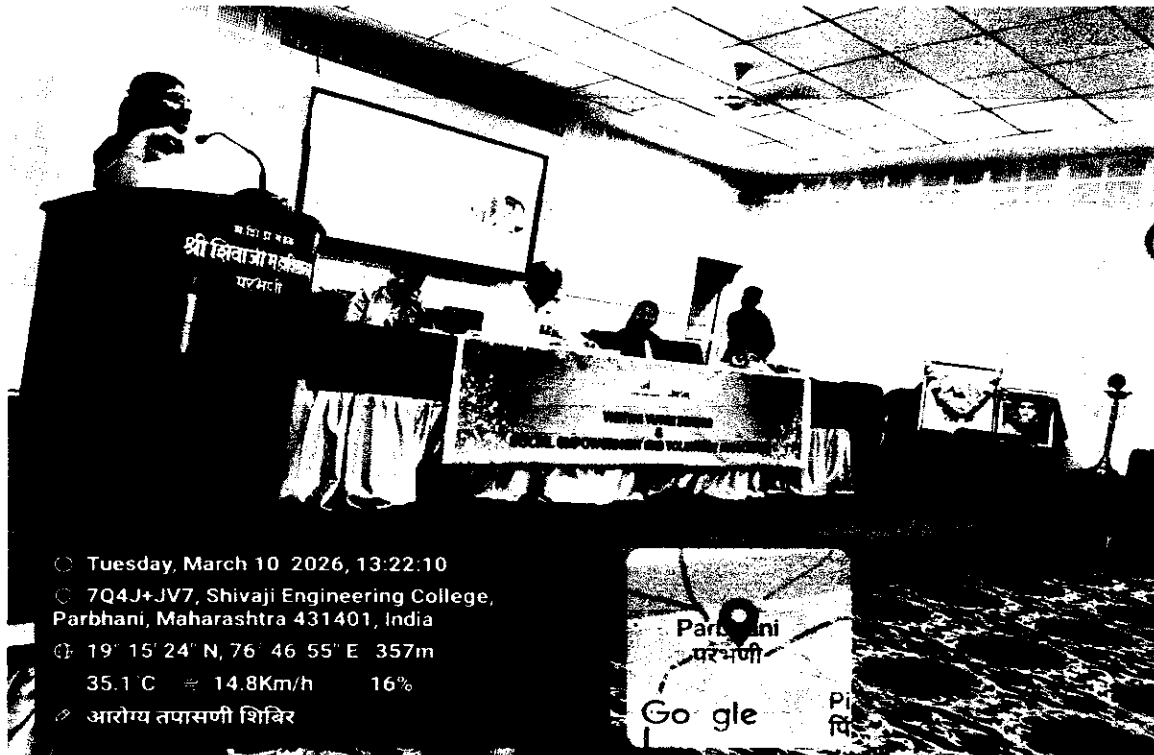

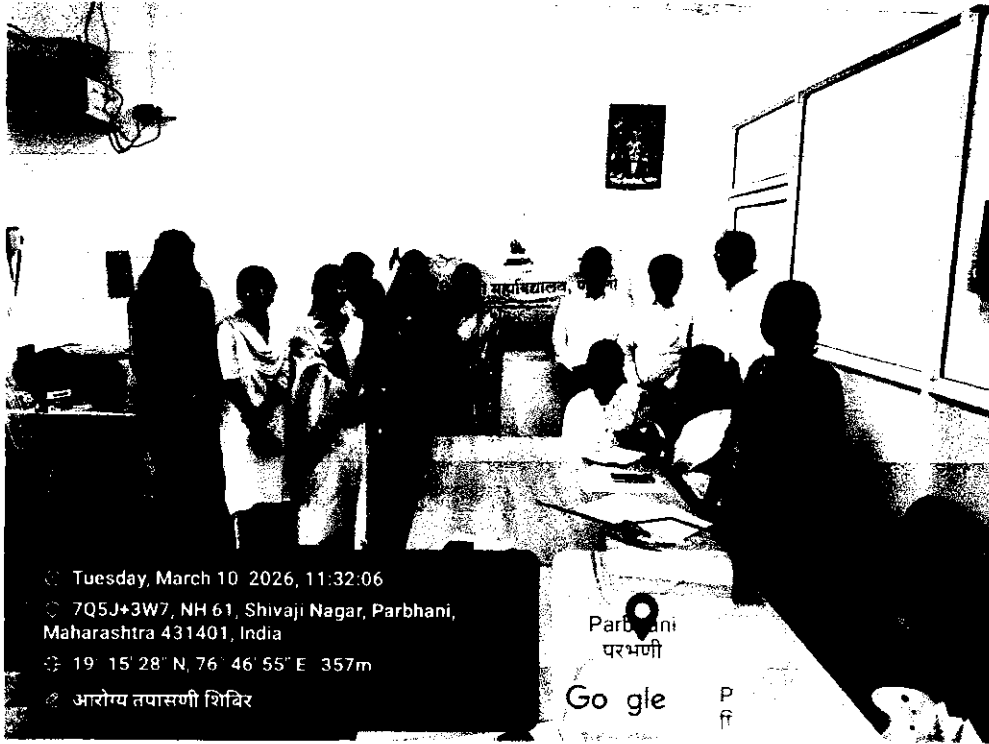

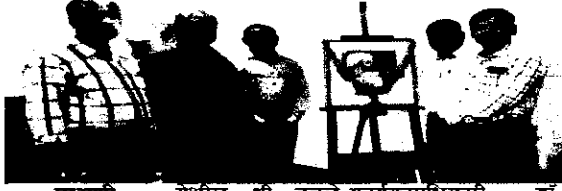
