Day one

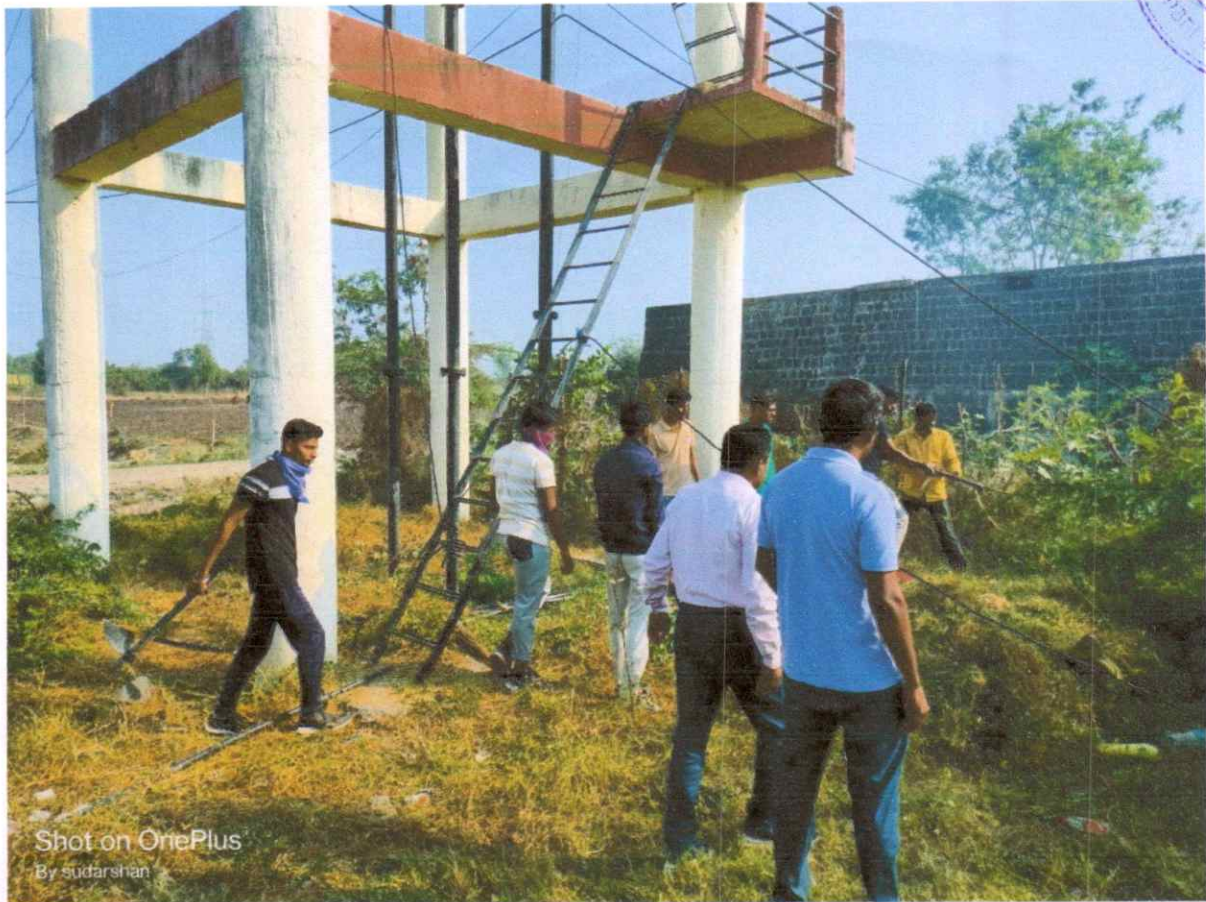

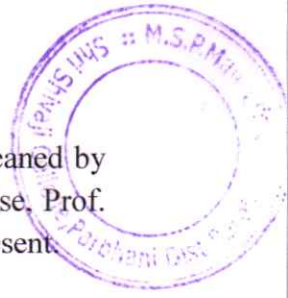
